

Annex EU Cofinancing Agreement: Supplements to the General Terms and Conditions for Contracts with Appraisers/Firms of Consultants (local) (December 2024)

The contract between GIZ and the contractor is based on a cofinancing agreement between GIZ and the European Commission.

Under the terms of this master agreement (Pillar Assessed Grant, Delegation or Contribution Agreement), GIZ is required to transfer a number of additional obligations to the contractor beyond those specified in GIZ's Terms and Conditions; details of these additional obligations can be found in Annex II of the EU Cofinancing Agreement (hereinafter: General Conditions) at:

Item 1.8 Use of GIZ's corporate design

In addition to Item 1.8, the contractor must ensure that all publicity, communications and/or visibility measures comply with Art.7 of the [General Conditions for Contribution Agreements](#) as well as with the current version of [Communicating and raising EU visibility: Guidance for external actions](#).

The contractor further undertakes to correct any identifiable deficits in the implementation of publicity, communications and/or visibility measures and to comply with the Communication and Visibility Plan and/or the Strategic Communication Plan under the EU Cofinancing Agreement.
